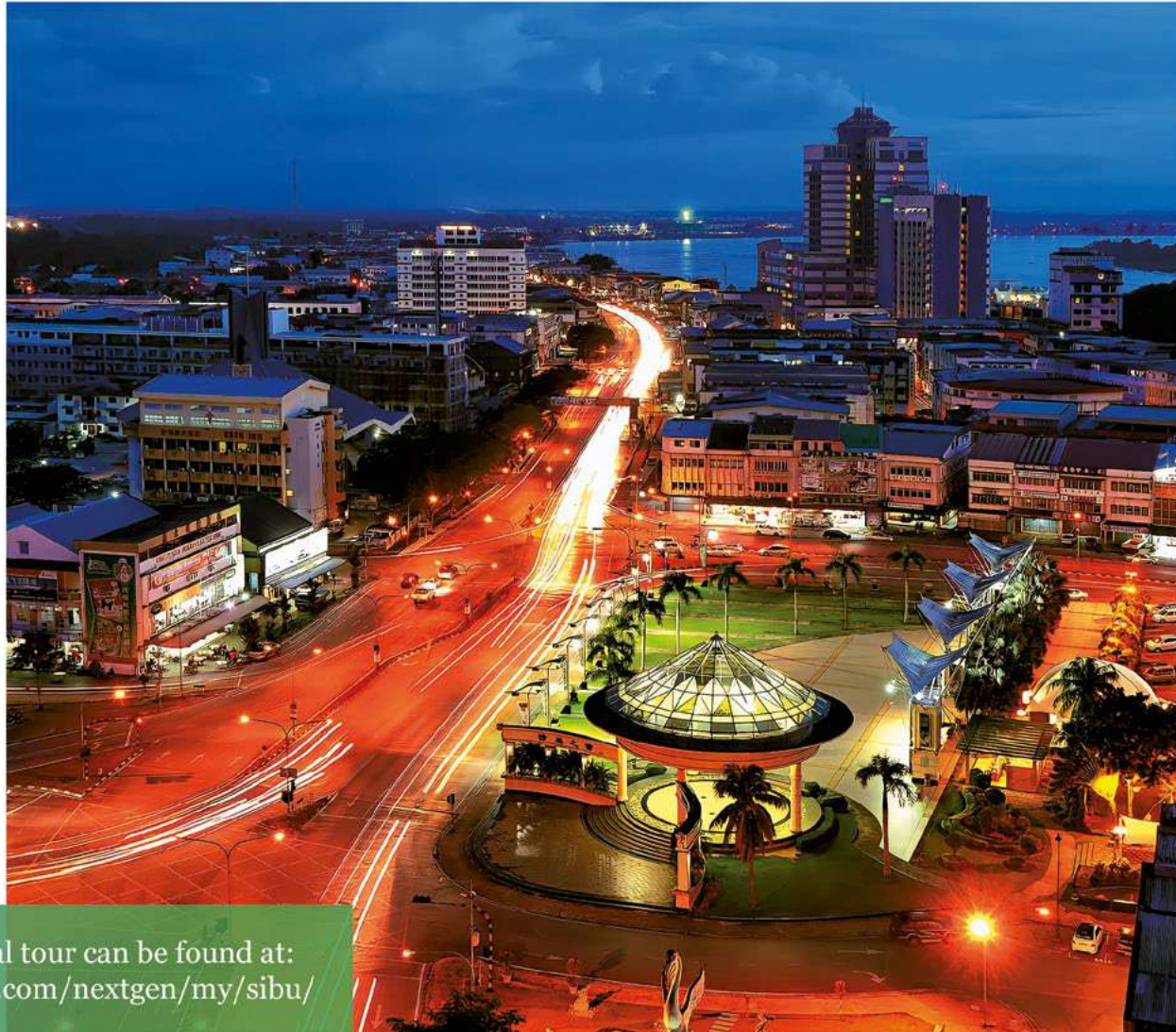

WHERE TO LIVE

The University offers on-campus hostels that are located just behind campus. The hostels are guarded by wardens and the prices start from RM1000-RM2500 per semester, furnished with basic amenities. All teaching at UTS is carried out in English (with the exception of some language-specific teaching) so we must be convinced that you have sufficient fluency in written and spoken English to cope with your course from the start.

VISA INFORMATION

UTS provides visa and immigration information to new students. This includes how to obtain a visa to study, information about your status, your legal obligations etc.

Application

WHEN TO APPLY

UTS has 2 main intakes per year. Applications to be submitted at least 3 months before intake starts.

- ◆ FOUNDATION INTAKE
June and October
- ◆ UNDERGRADUATE INTAKE
February and September
- ◆ POSTGRADUATE INTAKE
February and September (by coursework)
March, June, September and December (by research)



HOW TO APPLY



Ready the documents

What you will need:

- Previous academic transcripts/results
- English proficiency test results (e.g. IELTS)
- Passport size photos with white background (35mm×45mm)
- Copy of passport with minimum 1 year validity (all pages)
- Course syllabus (if request for credit transfer)

* All documents that are not in English must be translated by the Notary.

Make payment

Please make all the necessary payment as indicated in the offer letter in Malaysian currency. Any fees discrepancies (e.g. bank charges, loss in foreign exchange) from the payment made in currencies other than Ringgit Malaysia are to be borne by the students. All payment must be made payable to EDUSAR RESOURCES SDN BHD via telegraphic transfer. Payment must not be made to a third party be it UTS agent, representative or staff.

GETTING STUDENT VISA

Sarawak has different immigration policies that need to be complied with on top of the Malaysian immigration policies.

1 VISA APPLICATION

A. Initiate a visa application online with Education Malaysia Global Services (EMGS) by registering at <https://visa.educationmalaysia.gov.my>.

B. Provide information as accurately as possible according to your offer letter and passport details. Ensure that all documents are in order as this will affect your visa approval. Basic documents required:

- University offer letter
- Pre-arrival medical report (must be done at clinic that produces English reports)
Note : If you are coming from a country which is considered to be at a high risk of yellow fever, you will be asked to provide your yellow fever vaccination booklet/card before you can clear Immigration at the point of entry.
- Passport pages (all pages)
- Health Declaration Form
- Academic transcripts and certificates
- Passport size photo with WHITE background (35mm×45mm)
- English proficiency result

C. Make an initial payment for visa processing. Any unutilised amount will be refunded by the EMGS.

2 VISA APPROVAL

Once the visa application is approved by the Sarawak State Immigration Department, you can download the electronic Visa Approval Letter (VAL) via the EMGS account. If your visa application is rejected, you will be notified in writing.

3 SINGLE ENTRY VISA (SEV)

Use the VAL to obtain the Single Entry Visa at the designated Malaysian Embassy.

4 TRAVEL TO MALAYSIA

Arrange to travel to Malaysia once received the SEV. You will need to bring along the hardcopy of VAL for your immigration clearance upon arrival in Malaysia.

5 STUDENT PASS ENDORSEMENT

Do the post-arrival medical screening within 7 days of your arrival date for the issuance of Student Pass.

Please note that the procedures are subject to change by the Malaysia Immigration Department without prior notice. You are advised to check with UTS for the latest update.

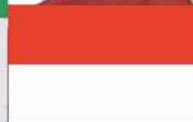
Bachelor of Food Technology (Hons)

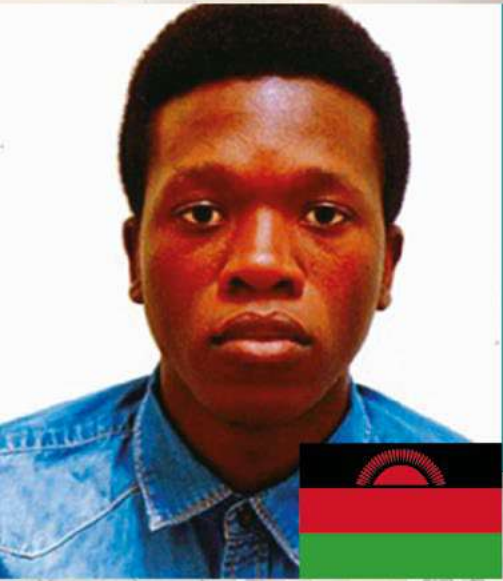

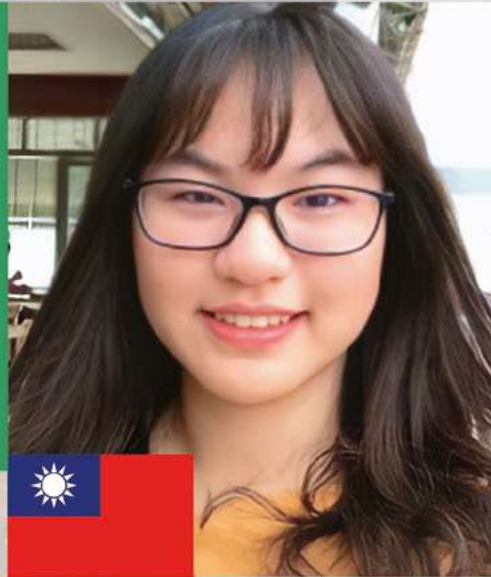

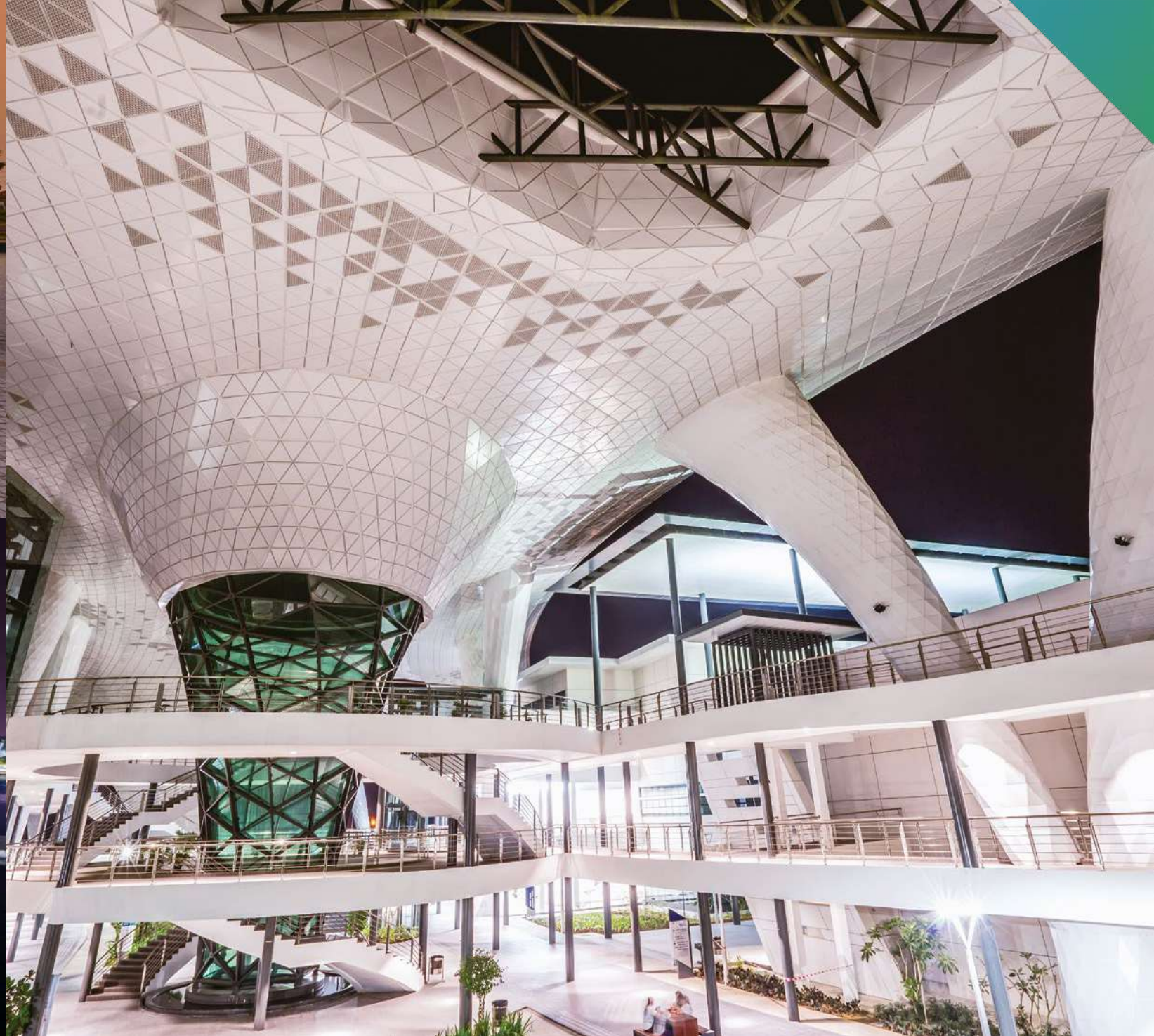
